
SECTIONS: During the Conference, the participants will present their reports in ten topical sections:

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Authors willing to present talk or a poster are kindly asked to submit a short abstract. The subject of the presentation must be within the scope of the conference. **Deadline for submission of abstracts is January 17, 2016.** To submit an abstract please use the form on the Conference website. An automatic confirmation of abstract receipt will be sent to you.

A Programme Committee will review abstracts of contributions for oral and poster presentations. Authors of selected abstracts will be notified by **February 1, 2016**. Talks will be length limited to 10 minutes (8 minutes presentation and 2 minutes for discussion). The size of a poster should not exceed the A0 format.

The WORKING LANGUAGE of the Conference will be English.
