Date/Time: November 17, 2022, 13:00-17:00 ULAT.

Conference format: Online (zoom link will be sent in advance before the due day).

Participants: Students and cadets in the field of studies in Scientific and research institutions, universities and foreign countries with cooperation.

Papers focusing on the following topics will be expected and welcomed:

General requirements for the conference paper:

- The articles should adhere to appropriate reporting guidelines and meet all applicable standards for the ethics of experimentation and research integrity;
- If there is any, the paper should describe experiments, statistics, and other analyses in sufficient detail and present conclusions in an appropriate fashion, and support it with data (for quantitative research paper);
- The paper should be written in MS Word, Arial font type, font size 12, A4, line spacing 1.15 cm, with margins 2 cm of sides, 5-8 pages;
 - Paper citations and references should follow APA format.
- Paper should be included the presenter's full name, title, short biography, a topic of study, keywords, an abstract, introduction, literature review, method, findings, discussion and conclusion, and references;
 - Participation is available for one presenter or as a team of 2 presenters;
 - Papers should be written in English.

Paper Submission Deadline: Papers should be submitted until October 28, 2022, via fa@uia.gov.mn, buyanjargal.n@uia.gov.mn. The Conference Organizing Committee reserves the right to select the most appropriate papers to be presented. The presenters accepted by the Secretariat will be informed through their e-mail addresses in advance.

Online conference: The conference should be organized online via Zoom Meeting.

The outcome of the conference: Papers will be published for public distribution which meet the requirements of the report and is discussed during the conference.

Speakers participating in the e-discussion will be certified.
